## **CSVT Update for Week of April 24**

**Montoursville**, **PA** – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland County as follows:

Lane closures for road widening work will continue next week on Route 147 north of Ridge Road.

Traffic will be shifted to the northbound side of the road while the contractor upgrades the southbound shoulder. The contractor will begin work Monday morning and continue around the clock through Friday.

This work will require lane closures with flaggers providing traffic control. Motorists should expect delays and plan their travels accordingly.

No work lane closures will be implemented during the weekend.

Bridge work is continuing at various locations throughout the project. Excavation and embankment construction will continue.

Work continues on the river bridge piers on the west side of the river. Seven of 14 river bridge piers are under construction.
