CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, **PA** – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

Route 15 northbound remains reduced to a single lane so the contractor can complete reconstruction of the highway. Traffic has been shifted to the center lane of the highway. County Line Road east of Route 15 is closed. A detour is in place using Grangers Road and Line Road.

Work will continue on the County Line Road bridge, the bridge spanning Route 15 and the interchange ramp bridge.

Wide loads over 14 feet are prohibited in the northbound direction. The single lane condition is expected to remain in place for most of the construction season. The southbound passing lane will be closed during the day for the northbound reconstruction work.

Drainage and earthwork operations will continue during daylight hours only.

Northumberland County:

Work on the southbound bridge spanning Chillisquaque Creek continues. Pier 1 is nearly complete and the contractor is expected to begin work on Pier 2. This will result in increased construction activity on Hidden Paradise Road. Flaggers will provide traffic control as needed. Route 147 traffic is using a temporary crossover to the new northbound bridge over Chillisquaque Creek.

Work on the bridges over Wooded Run and the bridges spanning Ridge Road is continuing.

River Bridge:

Construction of Piers 3 through 8 are complete. Construction continues on Piers 1 and 2 and Abutment 1. Concrete is scheduled to be placed for the abutment and Pier 9 caissons next week.

Erection of steel girders on Span 7 is expected to begin next week.
