CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, **PA** – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

Traffic is expected to be open to two lanes of traffic in both direction next week, weather permitting. These conditions will remain in place through the winter. Major earthwork operations will begin, with the contractor hauling fill over the temporary bridge spanning the highway.

Northumberland County:

The contractor will construct parapets on the Route 147 northbound bridge over Chillisquaque Creek.

There will be single lane closures under daylight flagging on Route 147 so trucks can haul material from the north side of the existing bridge over Chillisquaque Creek to the south side of the bridge, as well as to construct a temporary crossover to the new northbound bridge.

River Bridge:

Construction of the river bridge piers on the west side of the river continues. One pier is complete while work is ongoing on seven piers.

Work has begun on an abutment on the east side of the river.
