CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

The 24-hour per day flagging for the reconstruction of Route 147 north of Ridge Road in Northumberland County has ended and traffic has returned to two-way traffic conditions. Traffic is shifted to the southbound shoulder and travel lane while the northbound lane is reconstructed.

There will be intermittent needs for single lane traffic under flagging to complete this project.

Construction of the river bridge piers on the west side of the river continues.

Construction of acceleration and deceleration lanes on Route 15 north of Route 1020 (Grangers Road) in Monroe Township, Snyder County, which is part of the construction of the Winfield Interchange, will continue next week. The passing lanes on Route 15 are closed in both directions near Grangers Road while work is completed in the median. These lanes are expected to be open by Monday, July 10. The contractor is installing erosion and sediment controls and performing earthwork and drainage work.

A detour is scheduled to begin on a section of County Line Road located west of Route 15 on Wednesday, July 5. The detour route uses Route 1017 (Park Road), Grangers Road and Route 15.
