CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

Work will begin again next week. Daylight lane restrictions on Route 15 southbound and blasting with intermittent stoppages in both directions will resume.

Northumberland County:

Route 147 traffic has been switched to a temporary crossover to the new northbound bridge over Chillisquaque Creek. The crossover is needed so the existing bridge can be removed and a new southbound bridge can be built.

River Bridge:

Construction of Piers 1 through 8 will continue on the west side of the river. Piers 4 and 5 are completed.

Test piles for the abutment on the Winfield side of the river are tentatively scheduled for next week. Production piles are expected to begin within the next several weeks.

Construction of the abutment on the Northumberland side of the river is expected to begin next week. Concrete placement is scheduled to begin in about two weeks.
