CSV T Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSV T) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

The contractor will be setting beams for the temporary bridge over existing Route 15 near County Line Road. Work will be done during night time hours of 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

Complete traffic stoppages of 20 minutes will be needed to set the beams across both lanes of Route 15. Work is planned for Monday evening into Tuesday morning, October 2-3, Wednesday evening into Thursday morning, October 4-5, and Friday evening into Saturday morning, October 6-7.

The temporary bridge is needed for construction equipment to haul material over existing Route 15.

The contractor will be paving South Bound lanes next week during daylight hours. Impacts to traffic will be short delays due to trucks delivering material.

Northumberland County:

There are no major impacts for traffic anticipated for the week of October 2-6.

The contractor will be working on structures throughout the project. Earthwork will concentrate on filling the box culvert at Ridge Run and excavation at Acorn Drive.

River Bridge:

Construction of the river bridge piers on the west side of the river continues.

Most notably cap reinforcement was installed on Pier 4 with concrete placement scheduled for October 4.

The project is currently about 45% complete with the bridge itself currently 33% complete.
