CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

The contractor will pave in the southbound lanes of Route 15. The paving will be performed behind barrier. There will be intermittent traffic stoppages so delivery trucks can access the work location.

Work continues on the temporary bridge spanning Route 15.

Northumberland County:

There will be single lane closures under daylight flagging on Route 147 so trucks can haul material from the north side of the existing bridge over Chillisquaque Creek to the south side of the bridge.

The contractor will continue placing concrete on the Route 147 northbound bridge over Chillisquaque Creek. Traffic on Hidden Paradise Road and Ridge Road, which run under the bridge, will be controlled by flaggers. Motorists should take alternate routes to avoid delays.

River Bridge:

Construction of the river bridge piers on the west side of the river continues.

The project is currently about 49 percent complete with the bridge itself currently 36 percent complete.
