CSVT Update for Week of May 22

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project as follows:

Construction of acceleration and deceleration lanes on Route 15 north of Granger Road in Union Township, Union County, which is part of the construction of the Route 15 Interchange, will continue next week.

The passing lanes on Route 15 are closed in both directions while work is completed in the median. Although no work will be performed through the Memorial Day weekend, the lanes will remain closed.

The detour for Ridge Road in Point Township, Northumberland County, is expected to be lifted Saturday, May 20. The detour was needed while tie-in work related to the relocation of a section of Ridge Road and its intersection with Route 147 was being performed.

The relocated Ridge Road is expected to be opened later this summer.

Excavation, blasting, drainage work, bridge work and utility work along Route 147 will continue with limited lane closures under flagging.

Work continues on the river bridge piers on the west side of the river. This work includes excavation and construction of piers and pier foundations.
